

Have Pastor Brad Officiate Your Wedding

As you sit down to plan your big day, I want you to know that I am very happy for you and I'll do all that I can to help make your wedding and your marriage a great success. I married my wife, Kelly, June 22, 1991 and I've never regretted a single day of it. Marriage is a blessing. When a man and woman faithfully commit to loving and serving one another as God calls us to—the result is a life-time of relationship that is second to none.

I've performed a lot of weddings. I truly enjoy helping couples take this awesome step in life. Here's what I offer you:

1. Suggestions on options for personalizing your ceremony.
2. I'm happy to be a resource person for you—if you have questions about the who, what, when, where or hows of your ceremony. Every bride and groom has questions. I'm happy to help.
3. Premarital counseling—actually I require two sessions sometime within a month of wedding date. These sessions provide us an opportunity to get acquainted, work out details and talk about some very helpful/biblical relationship principles that will bless your marriage.
4. A rehearsal the night before your wedding. This usually lasts about one hour. We'll walk through everything and make sure you're comfortable.
5. The ceremony—of course. I'm happy to perform the ceremony.
6. Mailing your official documents to the state—making you officially married.

I have a few guidelines:

1. To keep things simple—I ask couples for a gratuity of \$100 for my services—due on or before the date of the wedding rehearsal (the night before the wedding). Please make checks payable to Brad Windlan.
2. No alcohol is to be consumed by the wedding party before the rehearsal or the ceremony.
3. You must both attend the two premarital counseling sessions before the wedding.
4. As a Christian Pastor – I want you to understand that I will conduct a Christian ceremony. I will acknowledge God as the creator and sustainer of marriage. I will offer prayers in “Jesus’ name” and I will incorporate Scripture into the ceremony.
